I also know that there will be traffic, hazards, debris and poor footing on the course and assume the risk for running on it. I also assume any or all other risks associated with running or attending the race including but not limited to falls, contact with other participants, the effects of the weather, getting lost, wildlife and insect attacks and all such risks being both known and appreciated by me and unknown. Knowing these facts, and in consideration of your accepting my entry fee, I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators or anyone else who might claim on my behalf, covenant not to sue, and waive, release and discharge Liberty Eagle Academy, LLC, Muscadine Creek LLC, and its owners in which the event is held, the race director, course officials, all other organizations directly or indirectly associated with the race, any and all sponsors including their agents, employees, assigns or anyone acting for on their behalf, or anyone else associated in any way with the race, from any or all claims or liability for death, personal injury or property damage of any kind of nature what so ever arising out of, or in the course of, my participation in this event(s). This waiver extends to all claims of every kind or nature what so ever, foreseen or unforeseen, known or unknown.

Picking berries may or may not by its nature be a hazardous activity, but occasionally an injury may occur. Amongst the myriad of things that might happen, you might trip and fall, get stung by a bee, get bitten by a snake, get a berry-vine-thorn in your finger, drown in the pond, eat too many berries or and get a tummy ache, find a bug in your berries, get sunburned, break into a sweat, get heat stroke and/or dehydration, a sprain or other injury from walking on trail or among blueberry field, or even get dive bombed by an irate creature of the avian nature whose dinner you have just purloined. Not to mention all sorts of other wildlife—squirrels, rabbits, lizards, snakes, Bigfoot, etc. Of a serious note in any event when you and your children enter the orchard, berry patch premises, YOU ASSUME ALL RISK OF INJURY OF ANY KIND! By signing this agreement, you agree to assume all risks of injury, harm or damage, whether disclosed or undisclosed, whether obvious or hidden, whether natural or man-made, whether to property or persons, and waive any rights or claims arising out of such injury, risk, harm or damage, against the Muscadine Creek LLC, Liberty Eagle Academy, LLC, or their heirs, administrators, representatives, executors, successors, transferees, and assigns. You also agree to abide by any posted signs regarding harvest exclusions and instructions. Ladder use or tree climbing is prohibited!

**Warning:** Under Georgia law, there is no liability for an injury or death of a participant at least 18 years of age in a registered agritourism activity conducted at this registered agritourism location if such injury or death results from the inherent risks of such agritourism activity. Inherent risks of agritourism activities include, but shall not be limited to, the potential of you to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to your injury or death and the potential of another participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to your injury or death. You are assuming the risk of participating in this registered agritourism activity."
